# Summary for 2004-05 Public Schools Facilities Cost Data

The Division of Support Services has compiled construction cost data information for public school buildings placed under contract between July 1, 2004 - June 30 2005. The list provides cost of construction for individual school projects and average state cost data, by school type. Based on this year's averages, construction prices have risen dramatically over the past year. When comparing this year's cost figures with last years numbers we have calculated a price increase for new construction of 24%, in one year. 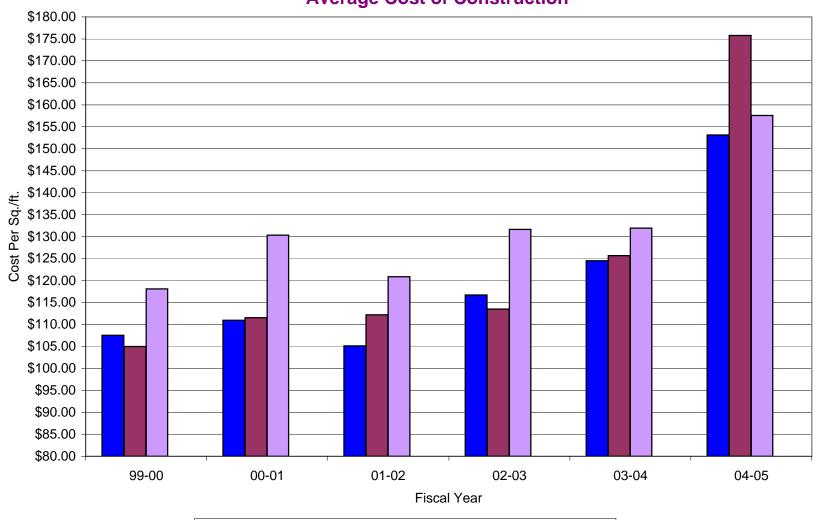
