This school refuses to hire or continue to employ any person who has a conviction of a barrier crime as defined in § 19.2-392.02 of the Code of Virginia or found to be the subject of a founded complaint of child abuse or neglect within or outside of the Commonwealth. A list of the qualifications of school staff who work in the preschool program including their job titles, education, training, experience and/or skills is attached to this statement.

This school certifies that all serious injury to or death of children attending the preschool program will be reported to the Virginia Department of Education at www.childcareva.com. Reports of serious injuries, which shall include any injuries that require an emergency referral to an offsite health care professional or treatment in a hospital, shall be submitted annually. Reports of deaths shall be submitted no later than one business day after the death occurred.
