Super School	User is responsible for VVAAS at their school. They manage the school accounts. They can make Custom Student Reports. They will receive school-level communications from EVAAS. They have access to associated school reports and all student data at that school. Position examples:  • Administration • ITRT • Division Super School User	2.	Failure: Must have 1 Super School User per school. Failure: Can only have 1 Super school user per school. User can be Super School at multiple schools. ## **Account Manager**

Why would you give someone the Account Manager privilege?

- 1. User can update accounts at their level.
  - a. Division users can support account management for Division All, Division NS, and Super School.
  - b. School users can support account management for the associated school. They can manage accounts for School All, School NS, School Teacher, and Teacher CSR users.
- 2. User can share Custom Student Report (CSR) built by the "Super" at their level.

Note: Most users should have an "N" for Account Manager privileges. This should be a very limited group of users per division or school.
