Fall 2023 Growth Assessment

(Effective for Fall 2024)

In the 2023-2024 school year, students in Virginia public schools will take growth assessments in Grades 3-8 Reading and Mathematics. Legislation passed in the 2021 Virginia General Assembly (HB2027 and SB1357) requires these assessments be administered to students once in the fall and once in the winter (mid-year). In addition to the growth assessments, the Standards of Learning (SOL) tests for Grades 3-8 Reading and Mathematics will continue to be administered. Test items at, below, and above a student's grade level may be delivered online via the computer adaptive algorithm as appropriate for the student. Please note that this test will begin with questions that assess either Grade 3 or Grade 2 English SOL. Students who meet the criteria for needing a paper test will receive Grade 3 English SOL test items.
