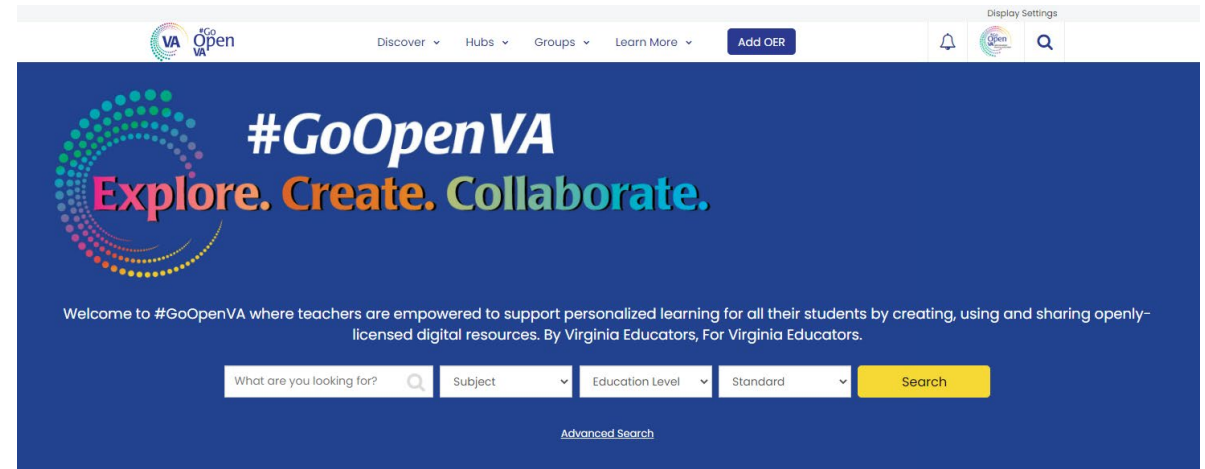

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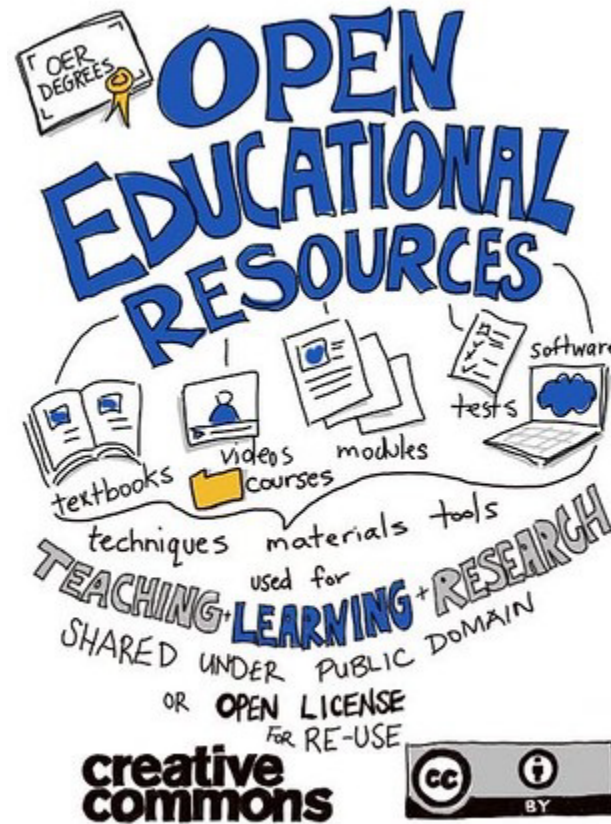
WHAT IS GOOPENVA?

WHAT IS OER?

- Teaching, learning, and research materials
- Different than public domain or free resources
- Shared under an OPEN license
 - Tagged with an open license
 - No cost
 - No permission needed
 - Revise
 - Redistribute



WHY WOULD I USE IT?

- No concern about copyright
- Financial and time benefits
- Supplemental Materials
- Sustainability
- Transparency
- Community of scholars
- Equitable Equal Access - the right to high quality content
- Empowers teachers have a voice and creativity in their instruction



HOW DO I ACCESS IT?

- GoOpenVA.org
- Anyone can access GoOpenVA to view materials. You do not need an account to do that.
- Registered Users
 - For a registered account, you must be an educator in Virginia. Some exceptions are made for education staff at institutions/organizations to upload educational materials. No students are allowed.
 - Registered users may add materials, evaluate materials, and interact with other registered users.
 - Use the division's single-sign-on (usually Google or Clever) software. If you are unsure how to use this, please contact your local tech support team.

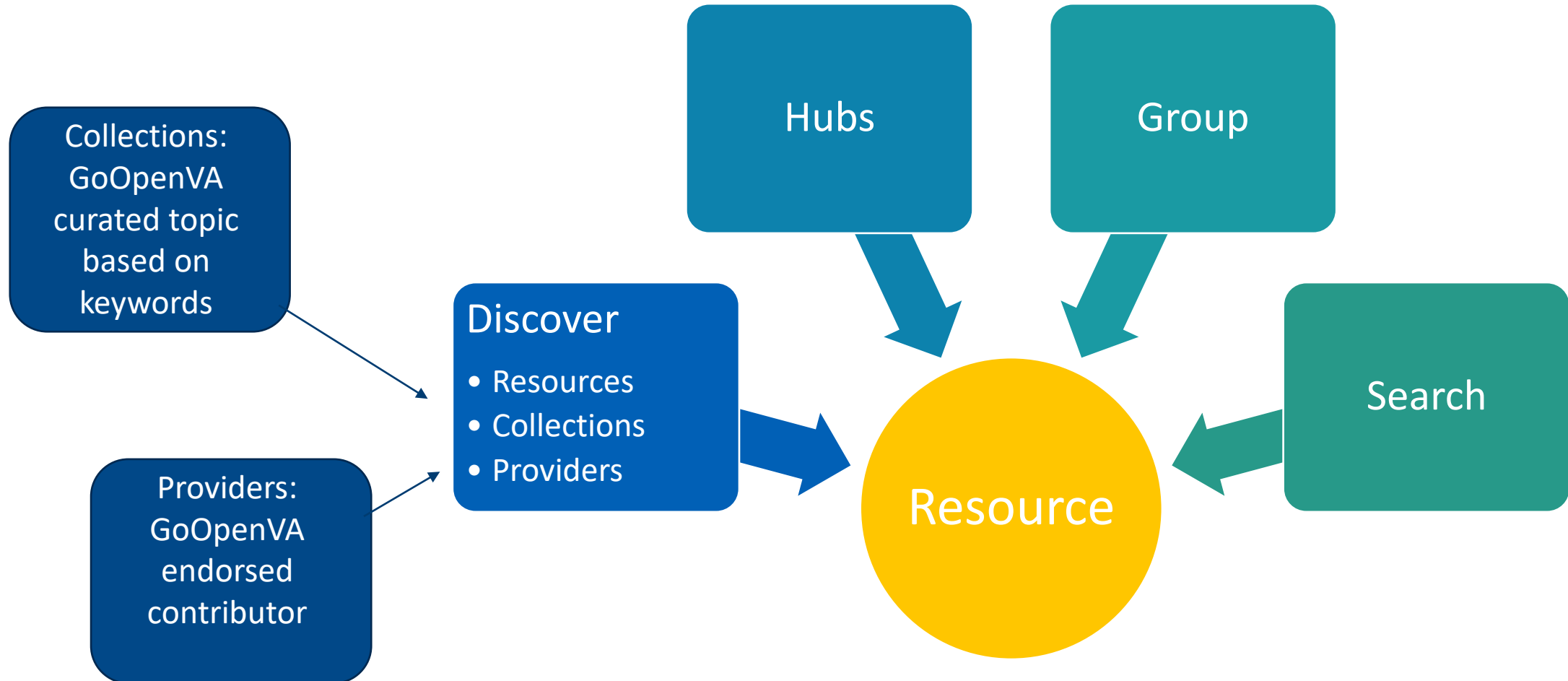

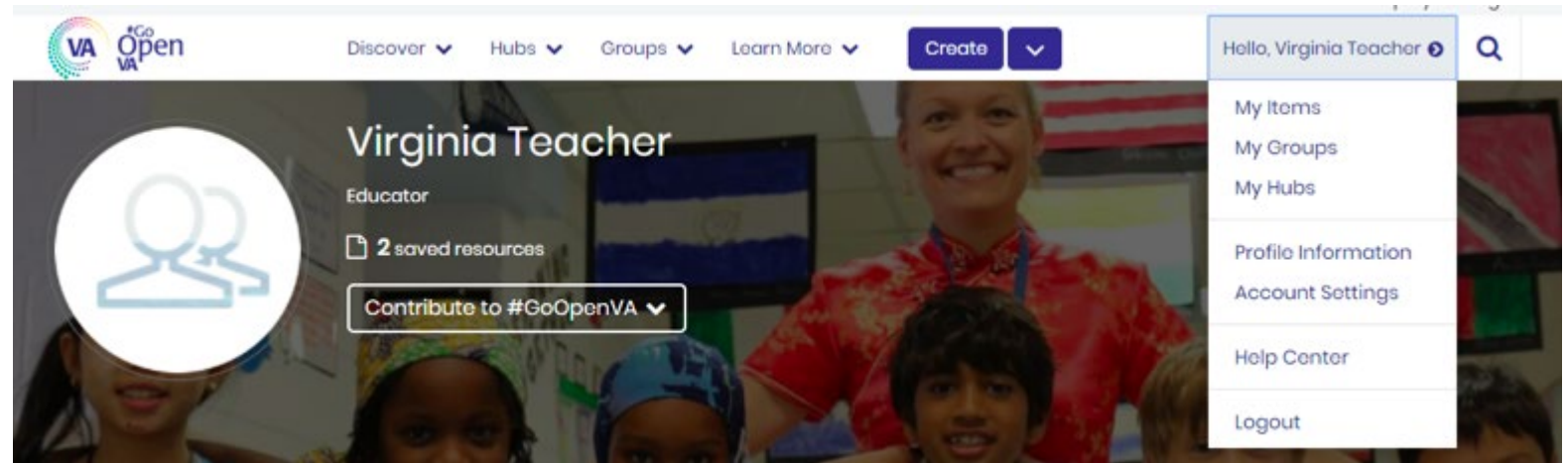

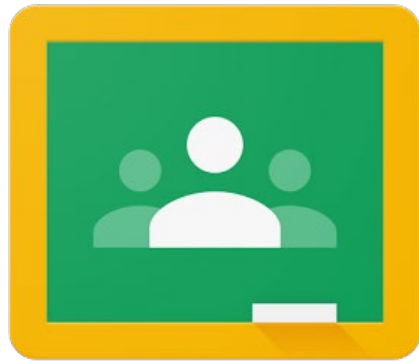

BY

You can use the work and do whatever you like with it as long as you give attribution.



BY-SA

If you add to or change the work, you must share it with the same BY-SA license.



BY-ND

You can use the work as long as you don't change it in any way.



BY-NC

You can use the work and add to it or change it but you can't make money from it.



BY-NC-SA

If you change the work, you must share it with the same license and you can't make money from it.



BY-NC-ND

You can use and share the work but you can't change it or sell it.

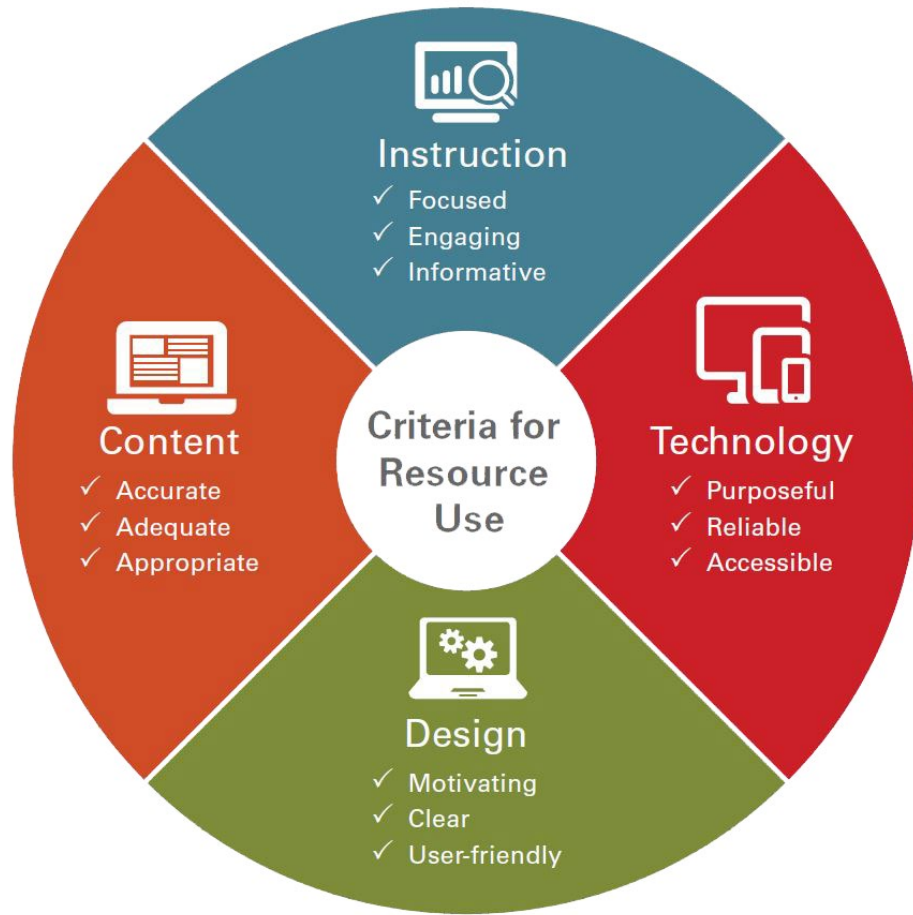

Description
Overview: I created this board game to give my 2nd grade students review of 3D shapes. They travel through space, trying to make it back to earth. This game supports sol 2.13, identify, describe, compare, and contrast plane and solid figures (circles/spheres, squares/cubes, and rectangles/rectangular prisms. Before playing this game, my students completed activities using manipulatives to identify solid shapes, the number of vertices, edges, and faces, and traced the faces of the cube and rectangular prism in order to build understanding of the relationship between plane and solid figures. My students played this game in small groups of 3-5 students. They take turns rolling a die, jump to the number rolled, and answer the question in the box they land on. My students love to play board games! As a result, they are more attentive and motivated to learn.

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO REMIX?

Remix: To adapt and publish resources.

- Localize examples to add regional relevance for your students.
- Adapt content for another grade level or adapt to match alternate learning styles
- Shift the focus of the subject area.
- Add something new to it like an assessment or a video.
- Update references to keep pace with new research and scientific discoveries



Find remixable content through the advanced search feature.

Once you find a resource, click the remix button.

Make the changes to the content as you see fit.


Once you click Publish, the original author will be notified of the remix.

Occasionally you may need to just add a broad URL. This is not generally helpful to most teachers because you lose the ability to remix the resource. If you find a site that might be useful which has great free resources, you can use the Submit from Web. Our librarians will review if the link is appropriate.

WHAT IS OPEN AUTHOR?

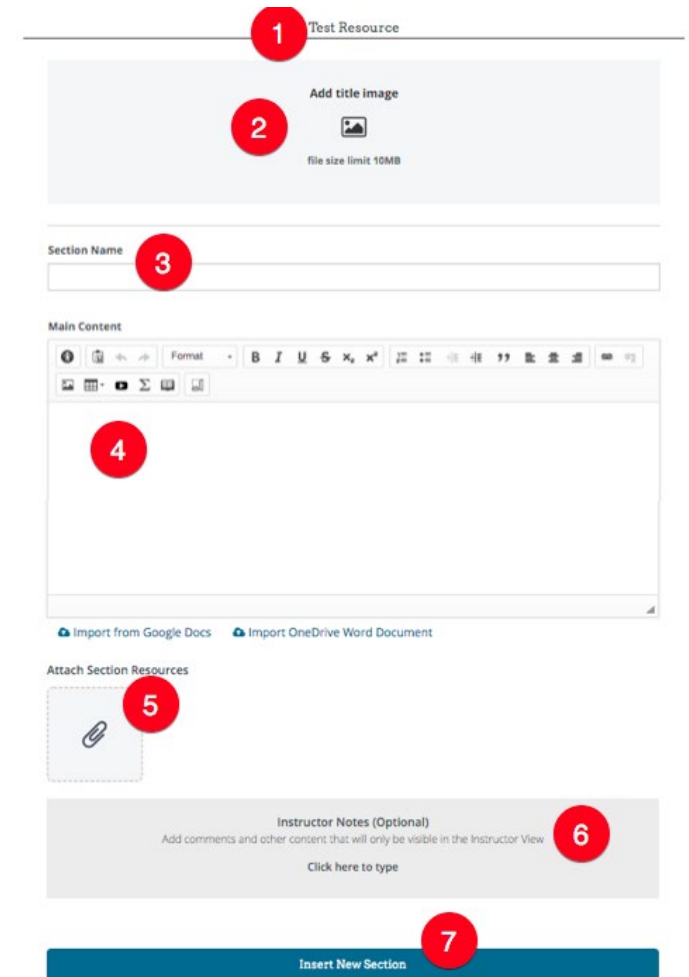
Open Author can be used to create many types of materials.

Customizable - Content can be easily edited with the toolbar

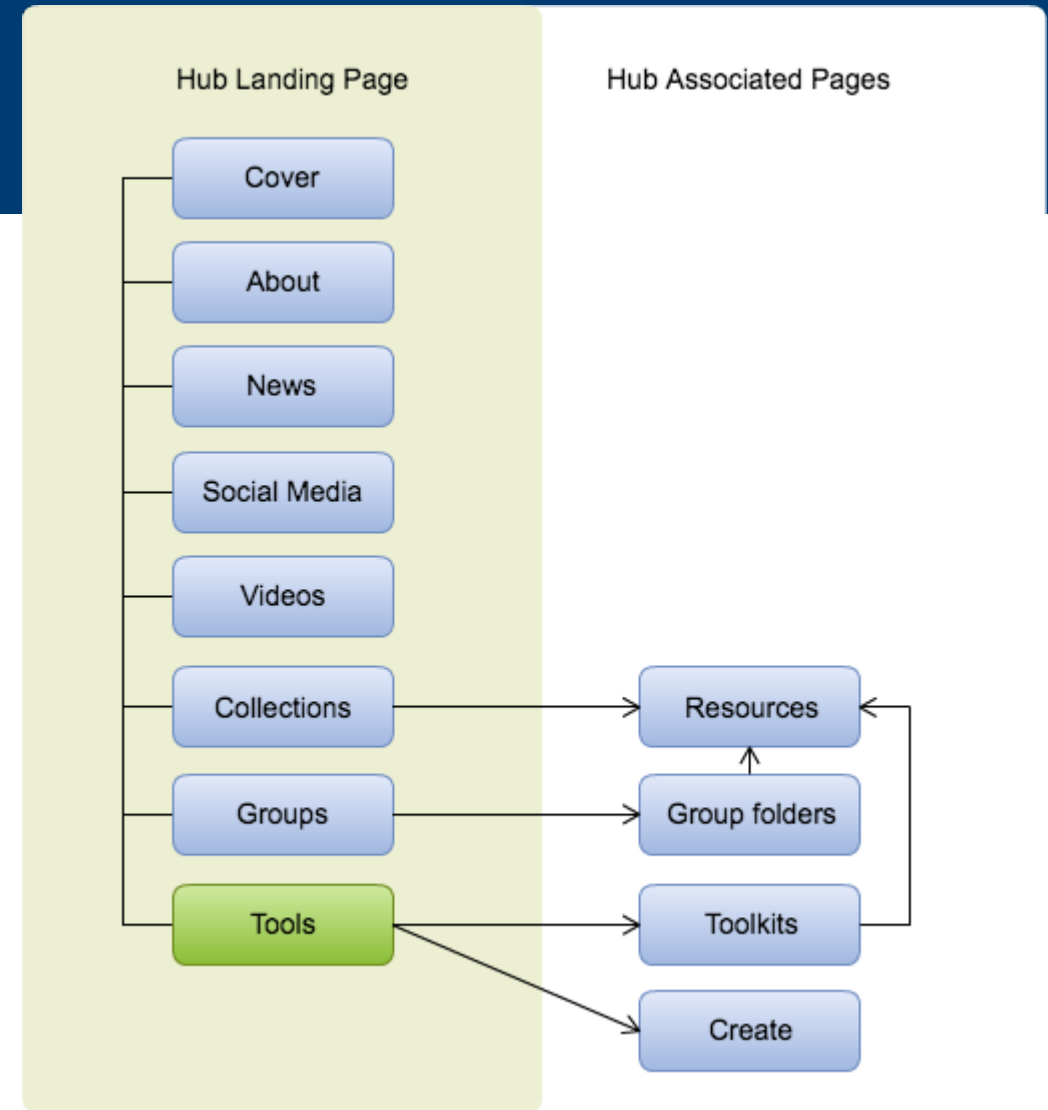

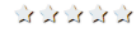
