VDOE-Approved Early Childhood Curriculum



List for Birth to Five Programs

Using Comprehensive, effective curricula helps support learning and development in all early childhood programs and settings. The Virginia Department of Education (VDOE) conducts comprehensive, expertled reviews of comprehensive curriculum used in eligible birth to five programs.

The choice to use an approved curriculum in at least one classroom results in some additional points toward the VQB5 Quality Rating: however, using curriculum is not required for participation in VQB5 or required to receive a rating that meets expectations.

Programs that would like to use an approved curriculum have multiple options:

- Option 1: Choose and use one of the VDOE-approved early childhood curriculum options listed in the table below.
 - There are four free/low-cost approved options
 - STREAMin3 available for Virginia ECE programs.
 - Early Learning Matters available nationally to ECE programs, including programs in Virginia.
 - Core Knowledge Preschool Sequence available nationally to ECE programs, including programs in Virginia.
 - Great First Eight (Infant/Toddler)
- Option 2: Seek approval for a curriculum your program already has in place. If your program's curriculum is not on the VDOE-approved list, review the <u>VDOE Early Childhood Curriculum</u> webpage for more information on how to request a curriculum review.

Important to note: Access to curriculum materials, resources, and professional development is critical to effective curriculum implementation. Programs/divisions should consider whether they have the internal capacity to train and provide support in implementing a curriculum in their planning and decision-making process for investing in a new, VDOE-approved curriculum choice. Programs should ensure that their curriculum selection meets funding requirements.
