RecognizeB5: Virginia's Early Educator Incentive

Coordinated through Virginia's <u>Ready Regions</u>, RecognizeB5 is a statewide strategy to support, retain, and reward teachers working in publiclyfunded Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) sites that are participating in <u>VQB5</u>, Virginia's Quality Measurement and Improvement System.



For the 2023-2024 program year, RecognizeB5 provides eligible lead and assistant teachers up to \$3,000 per year if they meet **ALL** of the eligibility requirements.

Lead and assistant teachers may be eligible if they meet <u>ALL</u> of the following:

- They work at a publicly-funded ECCE site that is registered in LinkB5 and fully <u>participating in</u> <u>VQB5</u>.
- 2. They registered in LinkB5 between August 15 and October 3, 2023.
- They teach in a birth-5 classroom (children not in kindergarten) for at least 30 hours per week at the same child care site from October 1, 2023, through April 30, 2024.
- 4. They are <u>not</u> a public school employee or paid by a public school division.
