Description of Project:	The project will replace John F. Kennedy Middle School with a new 800 student school. The current facility was constructed in 1965 and will be over 60 years old upon replacement. This school will be a newly designed and constructed building. The project can provide for the capabilities to address district-wide capacity needs. The preliminary target date for this project anticipates beginning in FY24 with completion in FY26. The project has been programmed in the adopted CIP of the City, with initial design funding of \$7,500,000 starting in the fiscal year 2023 budget.

Describe:	The classrooms, hallways and the auditorium of the school floods frequently when there is rain, creating potential hazardous substances. The building was retrofit with cooling but was not designed to be cooled. Adding the cooling system has created moisture intrusion issues with the building. The original terra cotta pipes under the building are collapsing creating sewage and storm water issues that could prevent the students from attending school. There have also been sinkholes that have created a safety issue around the entire campus.

RESOLUTION OF THE SCHOOL BOARD FOR THE CITY OF SUFFOLK, VIRGINIA AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A LITERARY FUND LOAN APPLICATION AND REQUESTING THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUFFOLK, VIRGINIA ISSUE GENERAL OBLIGATION SCHOOL BONDS FOR SCHOOL PURPOSES AND CONSENTING TO THE ISSUANCE THEREOF

BE IT RESOLVED by the Suffolk City School Board as follows:

Section 1: The School Board of the City of Suffolk, Virginia (the "School Board") hereby (i) requests, that the City Council of the City of Suffolk, Virginia (the "City") cause the City to issue its general obligation school bonds or notes (collectively, the "Bonds") in an aggregate principal amount not in excess of \$25,000,000, to finance some or all of the costs of designing, acquiring, constructing and equipping a replacement school for John F. Kennedy Middle School, which constitutes a capital project for public school purposes and (ii) consents to the issuance of the Bonds.

Section 2: Further, the School Board consents to and authorizes an application to the Literary Fund of Virginia (the "Literary Fund") for the making of a loan that will be evidenced by the Bonds. The Chairman of the School Board, the Superintendent of City of Suffolk School Division (the "Schools"), and such other officer or officers of the School Board or the Schools as either may designate (the "Authorized Officers") are hereby authorized to decrease the amount of proceeds requested to the extent the City and such Authorized Officers deem it necessary to issue the Bonds in an amount less than provided in paragraph 1 above.

Section 3: This resolution shall take effect immediately.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 23-R-002

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN APPLICATION TO THE LITERARY FUND FOR A LOAN AND PROVIDING INITIAL APPROVAL OF THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS BY THE CITY OF SUFFOLK, VIRGINIA, AS EVIDENCE OF A LOAN

WHEREAS, the staff of the City of Suffolk Public Schools (the "Schools") has presented to the City Council (the "Council") of the City of Suffolk, Virginia (the "City"), an application addressed to the Virginia Board of Education for the purpose of borrowing up to \$25,000,000 from the Literary Fund to finance some or all of the costs of designing, acquiring, constructing and equipping a replacement school for John F. Kennedy Middle School and paying any related closing costs (the "Project").

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUFFOLK, VIRGINIA, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. <u>Approval of Application</u>. The Council hereby approves of the submission of the application for a loan from the Literary Fund in an amount up to \$25,000,000 for the purpose of providing funds to financing the Project. The Council hereby authorizes the School Board to borrow such amount as part of the loan.
- 2. <u>Commitment to Pay</u>. The Council hereby commits that in each year during the life of the loan, at the time that it fixes regular levies, fix a rate of levy for schools or make cash appropriation sufficient for operation expenses and to pay this loan in annual installments and the interest thereon as required by law regulating loans from the Literary Fund.
- 3. <u>Final Authorization Required Before Bonds Can be Issued</u>. No bonds of the City that will evidence the loan shall be issued until the Council adopts an ordinance approving of and setting forth the details of the bonds and holds a public hearing on the bonds.
- 4. <u>Further Actions</u>; <u>Authorization of a City Manager</u>. The City Manager and such officers and agents of the City as may be designated by a City Manager, are hereby authorized and directed to take such further action as they deem necessary or appropriate regarding the application for the loan. All actions previously taken by the City Manager and such officers and agents in connection with the loan application are hereby ratified and confirmed. The authorizations granted in this Resolution to the City Manager may be carried out by the Deputy, Interim or Acting City Manager in the absence of the primary officer.
- 5. <u>Filing of Resolution</u>. The City Attorney of the City is authorized and directed to file a certified copy of this Resolution with the Circuit Court of the City pursuant to Sections 15.2-2607 and 15.2-2627 of the Virginia Code.

6. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage. This resolution shall be effective upon passage and shall not be published.
