SUBJECT: Virginia Literacy Act: 2024-2025 VALLSS: Grades K-3 Assessment Calendar

In 2022, the General Assembly passed the <u>Virginia Literacy Act</u> (VLA) to improve literacy outcomes for students in the Commonwealth. As part of the VLA, K-3 students are required to be screened by a single, comprehensive literacy screener. Beginning in 2024-2025, Virginia will administer the Virginia Language and Literacy Screening System (VALLSS) developed by the University of Virginia (UVA).

The <u>Early Intervention Reading Initiative</u> (EIRI) supports services to students in kindergarten through the third grade who demonstrate substantial deficiencies based on their performance on VALLSS. Students who score in the high-risk band on the VALLSS assessment are required to receive additional reading intervention services and a Student Reading Plan.

The <u>2024-2025 VALLSS: Grades K-3 Assessment Calendar</u> has been updated to reflect the requirements of students taking the mid-year screener. The mid-year screener is strongly recommended for all K-3 students, and students who score in the high-risk band are required to complete the mid-year screener to progress monitor the Student Reading Plan. The mid-year screener is much shorter than the beginning-of-the-year screener, only screening the decoding subtest.

The VALLSS: Grades K-3 Certification Tutorial is now available behind the <u>VLP website</u> login. Divisions should work with teachers who administer VALLSS to ensure they have access to this tutorial prior to the fall 2024 administration window.
