
ACTIONS OF THE 2020 VA GENERAL ASSEMBLY

§ 22.1-203.4. Public high schools; Virginia voter registration.

Each public high school shall provide to any enrolled student who is of voting age or is eligible to register to vote pursuant to § 24.2-403 (i) mail voter registration applications and voter registration information provided by the Department of Elections or (ii) access to the Virginia online voter registration system on a school-owned computing device that is accessible to such student. Each student who is eligible to register to vote shall be provided the opportunity to complete an application form during the normal course of the school day.

BACKGROUND

During the Vietnam War on July 5, 1971, the 26th Amendment was formally certified, and the voting age was officially lowered from 21 to 18.



EVERY VOTE MATTERS

2019 – Boston City Council At-Large decided by 1 vote

2018 – Baltimore County Executive primary election decided by 17 votes.

2017 – Virginia House of Delegates (District 94) close vote; recount resulted in a tied; **decided by picking a name out of a bowl.**

2016 – Vermont state House seat decided by 1 vote.

2004 - A special election in Radford, Va., for commonwealth's attorney was **decided by one vote**.

1882: - VA-1: Robert M. Mayo defeated Democrat George T. Garrison, 10,505 to 10,504.

WHO CAN REGISTER TO VOTE IN VIRGINIA?

- Be a resident of Virginia (a person who has come to Virginia for temporary purposes and intends to return to another state is not considered a resident for voting purposes).
- Be a U.S. Citizen.
- Be 18 years old (any person who is 17 years old and will be eighteen years of age at the next general election shall be permitted to register in advance and vote in any intervening primary or special election).
- Not currently declared mentally incompetent by a court of law.



HOW TO REGISTER TO VOTE

Obtain a **Registration Application** at the following locations:

- Online Registration
- Local voter registration office
- Download a PDF copy of the registration form

- Armed forces recruitment offices
- Public libraries
- Virginia Department of Elections office
- Department of Motor Vehicles offices

REGISTER TO VOTE SUCCESSFULLY

- Complete all information blocks on the application. If any information requested does not apply to you, indicate such by writing the word "NONE" or "NA" in that space.
- Sign and date the registration application.
- Submit your <u>completed</u> application by mailing it to the appropriate address listed on the application or delivering it to your local registration office.

CAN YOU REGISTER TO VOTE ONLINE?

Yes, if you have a Virginia driver's license, a learners' permit, or other DMV ID, you can! If not, then you can begin the registration process online.

You will, however, need to print out the application and mail it in.



HOW TO REGISTER TO VOTE ONLINE

Voter Online Registration Application

- Go to the Citizen Portal at
 <u>https://vote.elections.virginia.gov/V</u>
 <u>oterInformation</u>
- Select Register to Vote.
- You will need the number on your driver's license, learner's permit, or a Virginia ID from the DMV

- Type your name and the customer number on your driver's license, learner's permit, or state ID from the Virginia Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV)
- Click Next to continue.
