**SUBJECT: Revisions to 2014-2015 Title I, Part A, and Title I, Part D, Subpart 2, Allocations Under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (ESEA)**

This communication is to inform you of revisions to the 2014-2015 Title I, Part A, and Title I, Part D, allocations that were released through [Superintendent's Memorandum Number 094-15](#), dated April 17, 2015. Two adjustments have been made.

The 2014-2015 funding allocations for Title I, Part A, and Title I, Part D, were affected due to a downward adjustment to the bypass contract made by the U.S. Department of Education. The allocations increased for all school divisions and the Virginia School for the Deaf and the Blind due to the bypass contract adjustment. Also, the 2014-2015 Title I, Part A, funding allocations for certain divisions were adjusted in accordance with the reallocation procedures provided in [Superintendent's Memo Number 085-15](#), released on April 10, 2015.
